Our first 2005 outreach was in Panimaquin, Guatemala. This is a Mayan village where we constructed a work center to provide jobs for local ladies.

Days were spent pouring concrete, laying block, and painting. Evenings we were able to show an evangelistic film and share with local families about Jesus.

We were high in the mountains next to a live volcano! The temperature was always cool and we enjoyed learning some new skills. After wiring long slices of pine logs together on each side of the wall, we pour concrete into the hole forming a column that holds the wall together during earthquakes. (We only felt one tremor while we were there!)



Team members shared with local children about how Jesus died for us and was punished in our place. “To as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God...”
